## Campus & Transport Update

The following was issued to all parents this week from Aberdeenshire Council:

*“Aberdeenshire Council will be issuing all parents and carers a Transport Information Pack very shortly in preparation for the temporary move to Midmill School. Within this pack will be pupil bus passes and details of where pupils will be picked up from, including details of the pupil Escorts. If after receiving your transport pack you still have further queries, council officers will be available within the school hall on a drop in basis on **Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> October 2016 from 4 – 7pm**. A Home to School Transport guide was issued at a previous engagement event, further copies can be collected from the school if required.”*

Our Primary 2 pupils have been learning about farming as part of their local area study and will be receiving a visit from the Countryside Classroom On Wheels on Monday 26<sup>th</sup> September. Due to the classroom being at school all day, the Primary 3 children will also be given the opportunity to visit.



“The Countryside Classroom on Wheels (CCOW) is a purpose built, bio secure trailer designed to bring livestock, crop and feed samples to the school playground with the aim of introducing pupils to farming, food production and the countryside and raising awareness of

the kinds of animals and plants raised on Scottish farms.

The trailer will be stocked by a local farmer with animals and crops brought from his farm.

A CCOW visit enables pupils to see farm animals at close range and hear from the farmer how they are cared for. They can touch, smell and feel a variety of crops and feeds and hear how they are grown and produced.”
