We appreciate that some pupils are anxious about moving to Midmill. Mrs Farquhar held an assembly yesterday which hopefully addressed some of these concerns. Teacher's will be offering pupils in their class opportunities to discuss any questions they might have. We have created a story to explain to children the moving process. This is on the website, under the documents tab, please go over it with your child if you feel it is necessary.

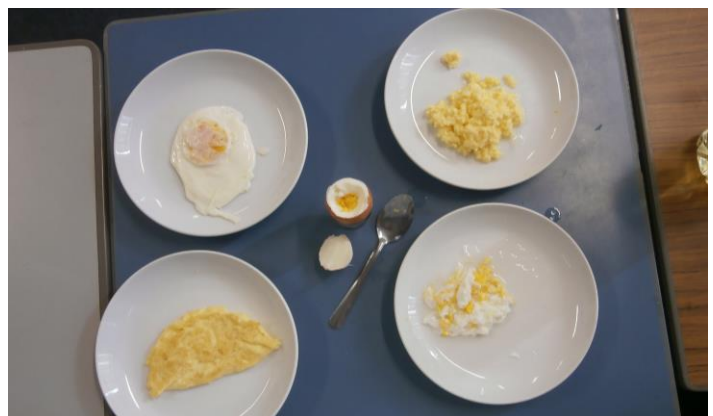
Primary 1
