School Transport

Please be advised that until children board the bus, they remain under parental supervision. The responsibility of childrens' behavior at the bus stops does not lie with the escort but with the children themselves and their parents. If you choose to send your child to the bus stop alone, please make the following rules clear to them:

- The crossing patrol must be used to cross between Badger Rise side and Scotsmill area.
- Stand safely on the pavement away from the kerb.
- Do not start moving towards the bus until it has stopped.
- **NEVER** walk behind a bus.
- Do not push and jostle to be first on the bus. This is very dangerous when the bus is approaching.
- Whilst on the bus, remain seated with seatbelt fastened at all times.
