Partnership with Parents/Volunteers Policy

At Kinellar Nursery we positively encourage parents to be involved with their child's learning and wish to work with each family to ensure a shared understanding and mutual acknowledgement of the child's developing skills within the Nursery environment.

We do this in many ways:

- Seasonal "Talking Boxes" are given termly to work on during holiday breaks to involve and promote family learning.
- Hold regular events and invite parents to share i.e. festivals and children's learning and achievements.
- Involve parents in the classroom: stay and play sessions and outings.
- Share information on the curriculum: Open evenings.
- Parent Consultations made available to parents if required throughout the year.
- Sharing Community and Parent Council events on Nursery Noticeboard.
- Share successes and concerns openly.
- Facilitate meetings when required.
- Engage in sharing information where there are concerns.
- Inform parents of our achievements, strengths and weaknesses, welcoming constructive comment and support.
- Entertain or support groups e.g. the elderly in the community.
