Scottish Schools Biathlon Championships



On Sunday 7 October, Bruce Flett P4, Juliet Brown and Aiden Lean both P5 represented Kinellar Primary School at the Scottish Schools Biathlon Championships at Aberdeen Sports Village. The sun decided not to make an appearance and the rain and wind made it challenging for the competitors but Bruce, Juliet and Aiden were not put off by the Scottish weather and joined 180 other school pupils' aged 8-20yrs from across Scotland. Bruce and Juliet both competed in the under 9 category, which consisted of a 25m swim, then a 400m run. Bruce finished 9th Under 9 Boy overall with a total score of 1334 points. Juliet finished 2nd Under 9 Girl with a total score of 2090 points and was also awarded the Scottish Saltires Under 9 Best Swim medal. Juliet's placing and points put her in contention to qualify for the British Schools Biathlon Championships in March 2019. Aiden Lean competed in the Under 10 category, which consisted of a 50m swim, then an 800 run. Aiden came 9th overall Under 10 Boy and finished with a score of 1436.

Bruce, Juliet and Aiden all showed great determination and sportsmanship and were a credit to Kinellar School. Special thanks to Scottish Saltires Modern Pentathlon Club for running this event and all the volunteers who helped make it happen.
