This musical first premiered in 2015 before moving to Broadway and then the West End in London. It was the first major production written by Justin Paul and Benj Pasek who then gained further critical acclaim by co-writing "The Greatest Showman".

It tells the story of Evan Hansen, a teenager struggling to fit in, and his journey to find friendship and self-acceptance. A film adaptation was released in 2021 with Ben Platt who has played Evan both on stage and on screen.

The choir will be performing 'You Will Be Found' which is the most well known song from this musical.



Matilda

This movie was filmed entirely during lockdown in Ireland and is an adaptation of the successful stage musical that ran from 2010 to 2011 in the UK and US. It is centred around 5-year-old Matilda Wormwood who has extraordinary knowledge and a great love for reading but her parents (particularly her dad) and the principal of her school, Crunchem Hall, think she's a nuisance. After seeing many of her classmates be tortured by the Trunchbull, Matilda obtains a wonderful power that teaches all the pitiful people in her life a lesson. Michael, her brother, does not exist in the two musicals, but is featured in the 1996 film. These productions were inspired by the 1988 book of the same name, which is also Roald Dahl's 2nd best sold book.

The P4s will be performing 'When I Grow Up' and 'Revolting Children,' both from this film.
